This program also collaborates with Open Access to provide a weekly Family and Friends Support and Education group every Thursday from 6:00pm to 7:30pm located at Open Access (1350 University Ave). ➤ The Peer Advocate Team (PAT) provides Peer support services to individuals in a person centered and self-directed manner in order to enhance that person's recovery. The Peer staff can support the person to engage in recovery-focused activities including treatment, support groups, peer support, and recovery community services. The PAT can be the bridge support between services to support the enhancement of a person's recovery.
