

## **Xylazine - Know the risks!**

## What is Xylazine?

- It's a clear liquid, commonly known as "tranq" or "tranq dope" which is increasingly mixed with heroin, fentanyl or other illegal drug supplies.
- · It is the active ingredient in veterinary tranquilizer.
- It worsens the life-threatening effects of opioids and may damage the ability of the brain to get enough oxygen.

## Symptoms of Xylazine overdose include:

- · Difficulty breathing.
- Excessive drowsiness, causes sedation, could lead to coma.
- · Low blood pressure, reduced heart rate and palpitations.
- · Rapid loss of oxygen to include lower brain oxygen levels.

## What to do in the event of an overdose?

- · Call 911 immediately and stay until emergency assistance arrives.
- · Administer naloxone (Narcan).
- Try to keep person awake and breathing.
- · Lay person on side to prevent choking.
